Four more arrested on drug charges

HUGO — Four additional names have been added to a list of area residents, who have been charged with two felony drug crimes.

Arrested and jailed last week in the Choctaw County jail for conspiracy to deliver/manufacture/possess CDS, was Billie Jean Vanderveen, 41. According to a spokesperson for the Choctaw County Sheriff's office, Amelia Wilhelm was arrested a few weeks ago.
