HUGO — City of Hugo residents may have noticed a change on their water bills this month, that includes an extra \$1 contribution or donation to the city's Parks and Recreation Department. Members of the Hugo City Council voted last November to add a new line item to the monthly water bills to allow willing residents to make a \$1 contribution to Parks and Recreation. The extra proceeds will be used for upgrading park facilities and city streets and electricity payments for the street lights throughout downtown Hugo.
